

# STEPPIN' OUT SKI TRIP TO TELLURIDE

## Feb. 20-27, 2011



We love Telluride and keep returning but this time we are taking it to a new level (literally) and staying right on the mountain. Ski-in Ski Out at its best. The Peaks Hotel and spa is stacked on the slopes of Telluride's ski mountain, this nine-story hotel caters to skiers, golfers, and upscale travelers who want lots of luxury and personal attention. The sprawling lobby lounge welcomes guests with an oversized fireplace, leather chairs and sofas, original art, and a three-story atrium that overlooks Telluride and the surrounding peaks of the San Juan Mountains is home to Colorado's largest health spa, the celebrated Golden Door. Occupying five floors, it includes a family level with an indoor/outdoor pool, spas, and water slide; children's pool, steam room, and sauna. The fitness level features an indoor lap pool, gym, exercise classes, squash and racquetball courts, rock-climbing wall, and outdoor tennis courts. Body-pampering treatments take place in 32 private rooms, with robes and slippers provided.

Telluride is a renowned Colorado ski destination, is a ski-lover's paradise. Telluride and Mountain Village are located in southwest Colorado's majestic San Juan Mountains. A National Historic Landmark District with Victorian-era architecture, Telluride is nestled in a box canyon at the base of the Telluride Ski Mountain (8,750'), surrounded by 13,000' peaks. The picturesque San Miguel River and river trail wind through town joining Town Park with the historic train depot. The town is less than one mile long, so all accommodations are just a short walk to Main Street shops and restaurants or to the two ski lifts and the year-round gondola accessing the mountain. The mountain has some of the most spectacular scenery we've seen. Beginners and intermediate, don't let the rumors scare you. There is plenty of mild terrain on this mountain, and what's best is that some of the easy slopes are at the top of the mountain, giving you the same gorgeous vistas that the more advanced people enjoy.

**Your Accommodation: Peaks Hotel and Spa (4 star rated luxury hotel)**

This amazing hotel is located amid the 14,000-foot Rocky Mountain peaks towering above the historic town of Telluride. In addition, during your stay you will be steps from over 125 Telluride ski trails on over 2,000 skiable acres and a short gondola ride away from the beautiful town of Telluride. The hotel features beautiful guest rooms that overlook the winter landscape while also offering free wireless internet throughout the hotel. During your stay you will have access to four great restaurants, heated swimming pools, and the largest spa in Colorado. Every morning you can pick up the newspaper and enjoy your included buffet breakfast in our group only area of the restaurant. ### **Getting Around Telluride: The Gondola System**

Boasting the most innovative transportation system in North America, Telluride's gondola transportation system has been praised for providing free, convenient, and environmentally sound transportation. Unlike other gondolas that simply serve as a ski lift, Telluride's gondola also links the historic town of Telluride to the nouveau Mountain Village. The Gondola, which eliminates any need for a car during your visit, runs daily from 7a.m. to midnight. The 13-minute ride eliminates the 20-minute, 8-mile drive between both towns. This popular scenic attraction also provides breathtaking views and free access to hiking and biking trails.

### **Mountain Ambassadors**

More than 30 staff and community members make up this friendly group of local mountain hosts. Directing guests to ticket windows and rental centers, carrying skis, and dispensing lip balm and sunscreen are just a few of the duties of our crew. Look for the Telluride Tent in the Mountain Village core where the guest service staff will valet your skis for FREE while you spend time shopping or eating in the village core. They can also answer any questions on entertainment, special events, mountain facts, mountain services, and dining favorites.

### **Daily Activities/Alternatives to Skiing: Not skiing or taking a day off?**

#### **Snowshoe Tours**

Visit the TopAten Nordic and Snowshoe area—located at the top of Lift 10—for daily snowshoe tours. The tours wind through serene spruce, fir and aspen forests and highlight Telluride's wildlife, vegetation, geology and history. The two- to three-hour tours are offered daily, and private group tours are available. Snowshoes are provided, but guests

should bring snacks and water and dress appropriately (warm layers, ski pants and hiking/snow boots). No snowshoe experience is necessary.- \$45 pp, bring a snack and warm boots, go at the ski school, leave at 10am-private are \$75 pp, can go anytime. Carson Taylor-970-728-7412 is the contact. ### **Snowbiking**

Not a typical mountain biking adventure, this bike with blades requires no pedaling, no climbing and no prior experience on snow. The bike rests low to the ground on two skis instead of wheels, and in the absence of pedals, riders strap snow blades on their feet for extra balance. Telluride is one of five Colorado resorts to offer this Austrian invention, Tuesday and Thursday from 1-3:30 p.m. One session is \$80 and includes a lesson and boot and bike rental (lift ticket is additional). Meet outside of the Mountain Village Activity Center.

### **Topaten Picnic Touring Area**

To access the TopAten Snowshoe & Nordic Area a "Foot Passenger" lift ticket can be purchased for \$20.

Here's the perfect activity for you on a day off the slopes. The Topaten Picnic and Touring Area offers 10 kilometers of groomed rolling trails for Nordic skiing and snowshoeing, a sunny picnic deck with restrooms and a heated teepee for escape from the elements on cold snowy days.

Located at the top of Lift 10, the Nordic trails offer breathtaking views of the mountains surrounding the ski area including Prospect Basin, Palmyra Peak and the Wilson Range, while leading you through serene forests and open meadows. Nordic trails are intermediate and are maintained for classic and skate skiing. Trails and teepee warming hut are open to the public daily. Guided, off-trail snowshoe tours are available for those that desire a more challenging workout while learning about our mountain environment from a knowledgeable local. A one-day lift ticket to access the trails via lift #10 costs \$10; uphill access in the lift 10 area is permitted and free of charge. Nordic trails maps are available at the trail head and at MV information centers including the new Plaza Nature Center in MV Plaza.

### **Ice Skating**

It's the classic winter setting. With a crackling fire to keep you warm, and gorgeous starlit night above, you skate across the glassy ice without a care in the world. Telluridians remember that setting, and the tradition lives on in both historic Telluride and Mountain Village. There's just something about the nighttime, the nip in the air and the warmth of a cup of hot cocoa that gets us. Skaters waltz by day and night in Telluride Town Park or in Mountain Village. The Town provides a warming hut with a fireplace for toasty toes, while the Mountain Village pond plays seasonal music under the stars. For free skate times in Town Park, call 970-728-2173, and for rentals, the Telluride Nordic Center at 970-728- 1144. The pond in Mountain Village offers free skating all day. Rentals are available at the Boot Doctors, 970-728-8954.

Telluride and the San Juan Mountains provide the perfect venue for a variety of nordic skiing options. In addition to the lift-served TopAten nordic trails, Telluride Town Park, the Telluride Golf Course, local favorite Trout Lake and the newly acquired Valley Floor offer several kilometers of groomed trail for both skate and classic skiing. Very little compares to the serenity of a nordic skiing trip through the Telluride wilderness. A vast network of trails ensure that you'll get the serenity you crave, as well as a great workout in the process! From the top of Lift 10, where guests can enjoy the serenity of Magic Meadows to the nordic loops in Town Park (3km groomed), Priest Lake (5km groomed) and Trout Lake, there are an abundance of nordic trails to explore. The Telluride Nordic Center, located in Town Park, maintains a groomed trail report and offers nordic equipment rentals.

The San Juan Mountain Range has established itself as an area with excellent cross-country ski trails. The Telluride Nordic Center, located at the east end of town Park, offers more than 50 kilometers of tracked trails. Telluride Town Park, the golf course and Lift 10 into Magic Meadows accesses breathtaking scenery while ensuring a workout. (970) 728-1144. For more of a historical experience, Ironton Park nine miles south of Ouray on Hwy 550 offers five miles of groomed trails into an old ghost town. Or for those seeking more adventurous terrain,

### **Dog Sledding**

"Mush!" We're not talking gruel, we're talking to sled dogs. In dog sledding, unlike other sports involving animals,

Winter fly fishing in Telluride is one of the best-kept secrets in Colorado. Telluride Outside has guides available every day during the winter, with quality public water and exclusive private water alternatives. You'll find excellent winter fishing on both the Uncompahgre and San Miguel Rivers, both within easy day trip distance of Telluride and Mountain Village. Top quality rental equipment is available, so don't worry about packing for two sports. You'll be pleasantly surprised. Winter is a beautiful season on our rivers.

### **Town Park**

Located on the east edge of town, toward the head of the valley is Town Park. This is a place to have civilized relaxation and organized sports. Town Park boasts a wide variety of summer and winter sport venues. When there is no snow on the ground, you can play baseball, basketball, tennis, or use the half pipe skate facility. There is also enough room to just play frisbee or catch. When there is snow on the ground, cross-country ski, play broom-ball, ice-skate, or play ice hockey. Town Park is also the site on many of Telluride's largest festivals. From its large stage,

It is a summit hike with an intermediate climbing grade. Ungroomed trails are very popular with snowmobilers, skiers and snowshoers. Lizard Head is located 18 miles south of Telluride.

#### **Alta Lakes**

Travel to the historic town of Alta lakes 6 miles south of Telluride off of Hwy. 145. Gather around a campfire or go on a snowmobile adventure. Alta Lakes is also known a historic ghost town.

**Details of Coverage:**

- **Trip Cost: Trip Cancellation & Interruption:** Covers you up to a maximum of 150% of trip cost if a trip is canceled or interrupted due to any of the covered unforeseen circumstances such as sickness, injury, death of you or a family member, inclement weather causing cancellation or interruption of travel.
