JACKSON HOLE: January 28- Feb. 4

Details of Coverage:

- **Trip Cost: Trip Cancellation & Interruption:** Covers you up to a maximum of 150% of trip cost if a trip is canceled or interrupted due to any of the covered unforeseen circumstances such as sickness, injury, death of you or a family member, inclement weather causing cancellation or interruption of travel. - **Trip Interruption - Return Air Only:** Covers the additional transportation expenses incurred by the Insured to the Return Destination for 150% of trip cost or \$750, whichever is greater.
